

Butterfly Footprints

Supplies: Large white paper – Paint – Markers – Glitter – Other decorating materials

Put the children's footprints on the paper (separate to make wings of a butterfly). After they have dried have the children draw the body between the "wings" and decorate the wings to design their own unique butterfly.

Insect Collage

Supplies: Contact paper – Construction paper or tissue paper

Cut the contact paper in the shape of an insect (butterfly, ladybug, etc). Cut 2 insect shapes per child. Let the children put the construction paper or tissue paper on one sticky side, layer the other insect cutout onto it and make an insect collage.

Punch a hole at the top and hang the insect from the window. These bugs you won't mind hanging around.
